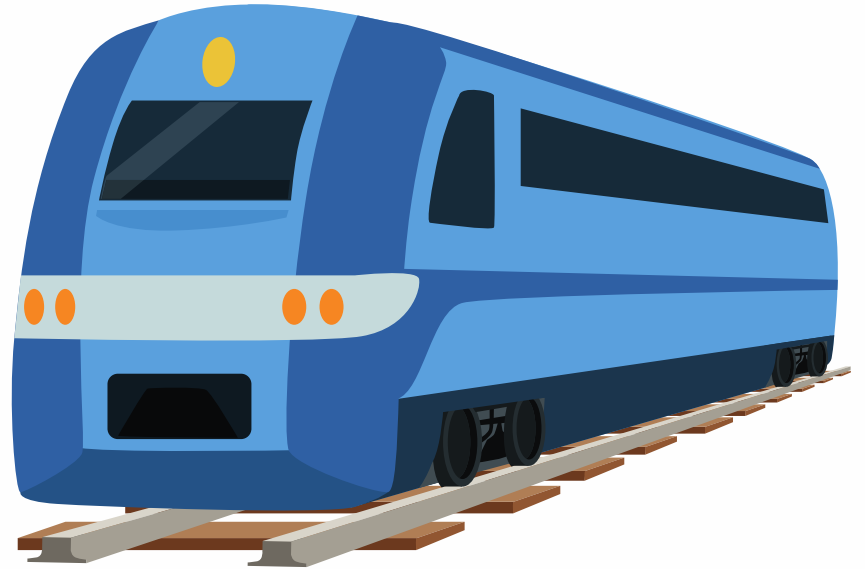
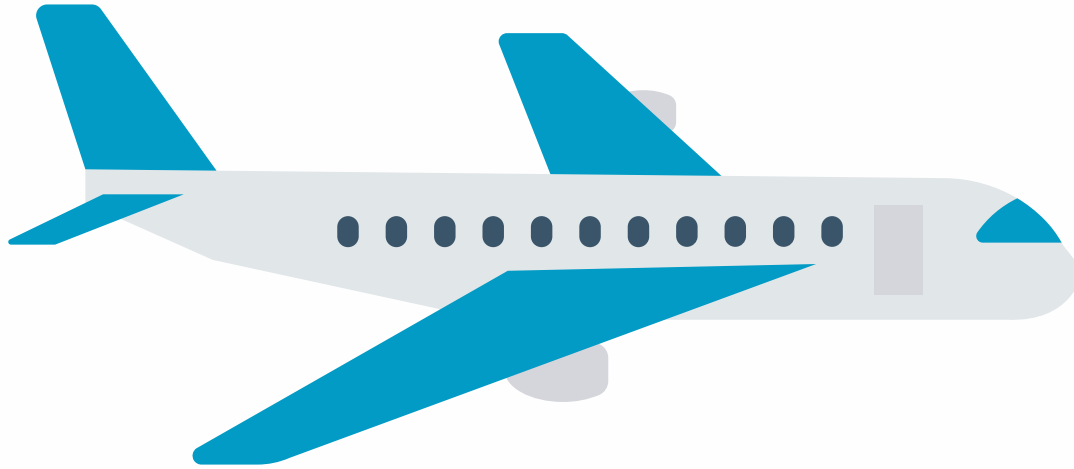
Thanksgiving is a holiday in November.

together for a big meal.



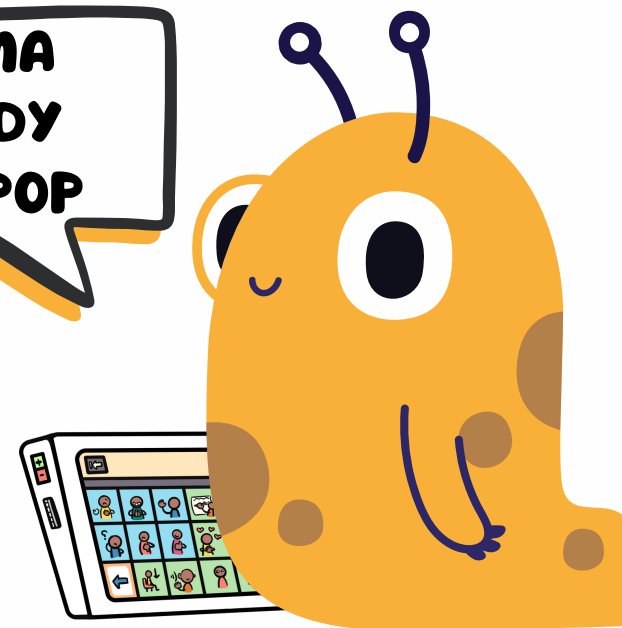
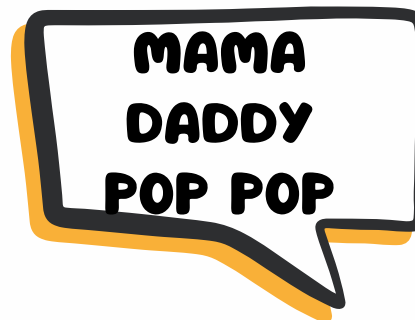
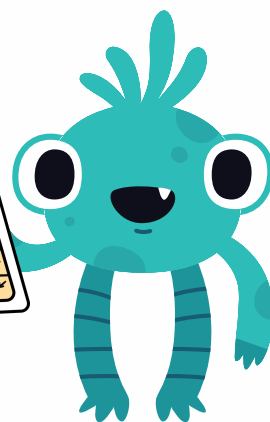
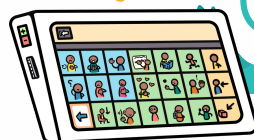
