Laminate and review to help your child learn the routine. Building a routine helps reduce stress and anxiety.

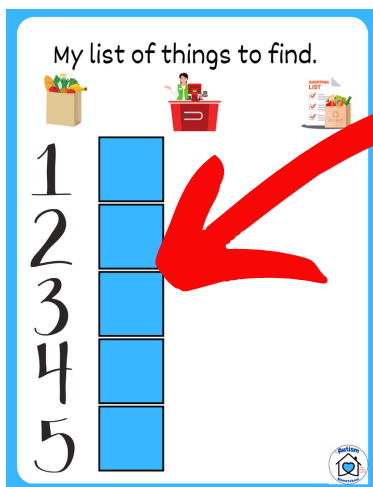
