



TAKING A SHOWER



A SOCIAL STORY






First, I remove my clothes.

get wet.






Next, I turn on the water.

too hot, not too cold.





I get my body wet.
This helps me get ready to use soap.







I get my soap.
Soap helps wash away dirt and germs.






I wash my arms, my chest, and my stomach.

I can't miss any parts.






I wash my privates, my back, and my bottom.
My body is all clean!





Now I rinse off my body.
The water washes away the soap.






I get my shampoo.
Shampoo helps my hair stay clean.






I wash my hair with shampoo.
Then I rinse my hair with water.







When I am done, I turn off the water.
